

2026 Research Student Application for Admission

To all applicants wishing to enroll from **April 2027**:

The application guidelines are scheduled to be released in or after September 2026. Please note that starting from this upcoming admission cycle, you will be required to submit certificates proving your language proficiency (such as JLPT or TOEIC) and documentation regarding your financial capability (covering tuition and living expenses), among other required materials.

Please be aware that the requirements are subject to change from the current 2026 guidelines, which are presently available for reference. For further details, please contact the admissions office.

1. Term: 1 year (If permission is granted, the applicant may stay for a longer period.)

Starting Month for Spring Semester: April

Starting Month for Fall Semester: October

2. Applicant's Qualifications: University graduate
3. Application: Applicants are required to obtain the acceptance of a TTI supervisor prior to the application and send or bring the documents shown below to the administration office.

Application period:

For Spring semester, 2026 — November 1-30, 2025

For Fall semester, 2026 — May 1-31, 2026

Documents to be submitted:

- ①Application form for a Research Student
- ②Personal Information Sheet
- ③Transcript of academic grades/scores from applicants' university
- ④Degree certificate
- ⑤Document to prove payment of entrance examination fee
- ⑥Declaration of Applicable Specific Categories

*If you choose to send the documents by postal mail, please make sure to have them sent by registered mail.

*Submitted documents will not be returned.

4. Evaluation

Evaluation of the applicants is carried out by document screening and interview.

After document screening, results will be sent to the applicants, and the candidates will be requested to attend an interview if deemed necessary by the screening committee.

Information about the date of the interview will be sent together with the result of the document screening.

Entrance examination fee is 12,000 JPY. Applicants are requested to make the payment by transferring the said amount to the bank account of Toyota Technological Institute, and to send the receipt to the Institute along with the application documents stated in section 3.

Please note that the application without a successful payment will be regarded incomplete, and thus not qualified for evaluation.

Admission fee: 130,000 JPY

Research fee: 175,000 JPY for 6 months
